From our trip coordinator John: Thanks to trip coordinator Carol Bronisz we can ski on foreign snow through a delightful trip to Canada, our great friends to the North. So come one come all to Manning Park where you will stay at the warm Chalets that allow you to enjoy not only fine groomed trails right out your door, but a pool, hot tub and dry snow. There is a central kitchen (meals are on your own or as a group), two wings with bunks (4) one double per end, thus 12 persons per chalet. You also can tear up your really nice and expensive gloves on the rope tow as your trail pass includes its use or abuse (depending on your outlook). The trip is scheduled for January 18-21st, 2008. The

cost is \$126 dollars with a deposit for the full amount by 12/10/07.

Sleeping Lady, Jan or Feb.

I am planning on scheduling a trip to The Sleeping Lady Resort, by Leavenworth, the last week in January or the first or second week in February, Sunday through Tuesday. I am waiting to firm up the date until after the Holidays in order to be sure of the weather and good snow conditions. We will go for the "Great Escape Rate" which is Sunday through Thursday, excluding holidays. That is \$380 for two nights double occupancy, private room and bath and gourmet breakfast and dinner. Single occupancy is \$280. There are 8 K of groomed trails across the road from the resort. A Lunch Pantry by the trail for lunch or a hot drink. The resort offers an outdoor hot pool, fitness center and beautiful outdoor sculpture

throughout the grounds. Sleeping Lady is a three hour drive from Bellingham over Hwy 2.

Ten of us went there last January and we had a great time and wonderful skiing. We all booked rooms in the same courtyard and gathered at one table for dinner and breakfast. We called ourselves "The Pampered Ten"!

Cross Country Ski Trails: Icicle River Trail, right out side your door at Sleeping Lady, Golf Course Trail, two miles from Sleeping Lady, Ski Hill Trail, adjacent to downtown Leaven worth, 8 km through a pine forest and lighted at night, Lake Wenatchee Trail, 25 minutes away with 15 km of groomed trails, just beyond Stevens Pass is the Nordic Center and we like to ski there on the way to Leavenworth.

Washington

Sno-Park permits are accepted in Washington, Oregon & Idaho. Where do the permit fees go? Specifically, they go to SALMON RIDGE! Proceeds from permit sales are used to maintain and improve nonmotorized Sno-Park facilities. They pay for snow removal, sanitation facilities, trail grooming, trail signs, mapping, parking lot construction, enforcement education, and program administration. Cost: 1 day permit: \$10, Seasonal permit: \$30. There is a \$1 fee added to the permits if you buy them through a merchant. If you buy through the club you can get the annual permit for \$30 (sorry, we don't carry the 1 day permit).
